- 2. (S-SS) Cuing: Locate LTC Higgins on a map.
- 3. (S-SS) Results:
 - a. The session was performed in two dowsings. Both halves of the session were performed by using a type of "CRV dowsing". I first accessed Higgins' location, using the straight CRV mode. Once a perception (or "feeling") was perceived and identified, I moved my hands to the map and searched over its surface to find that "feeling" again. All the places on the map where that "feeling" occurred, even slightly, were marked. Then the process was repeated for other "feelings". The point where the majority of these "feelings" overlapped was selected as the dowsed place.
 - b. The first half of the session was performed using a map of Lebanon. This located LTC Higgins in the southwestern part of Berrut, between the city proper and the airport. This seems to have been a successful dowsing.
 - c. The second half of the session was performed using a map of Beirut. This located LTC Higgins about 3 miles off the northern coast, in the Mediterranean Sea. Unless he is on a ship, this dowsing was obviously not successful.
