

- 2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: 003 was instructed to write the cue HIGGINS/PRESENT LOCATION at the beginning of the session, then provided with the "coordinate" 8809. After acquiring and describing the target, the viewer was then allowed to work with a map in an attempt to pin down the target's location.
- 3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: 095 is still undergoing Stage 6 training and does not have a good feel for either cardinal directions or dimensionality. 095 is confident, however, that the "bizarre" structure (see p.3) which 095 could not sketch, is the same structure perceived by viewer 011 during another session. - 3. EACKGROUND: US Marine LTC William Richard (Rich) Higgins while returning to the UN peace keeping force at Naqurah (UNIFIL) located 15 miles south of Tyre, Lebanon. He was abducted by three assailants near Ras Ain located four miles south of Tyre. The coastal track where he was abducted is contested by the Iranian backed "Hezbollah" and the Amal, a Lebanese military force who welcome the UN force in the area. The Amal is also conducting a search for Higgins.

4. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION:

- a. Utilizing a composite map featuring Lebanon as the principal country and a second map of Beirut, access and describe the location of US Marine LTC Rich Higgins. Use other Middle East maps as appropriate. Start from the point of abduction near Ras Ain and Tyre.
- b. Prepare and sketch appropriate overhead perceptions:

- c. Once the target site, structure where LTC Higgins is being held hostage has been determined, identify a readily and publicly identifiable object, structure located in the immediate vicinity of Higgins place of detention.
