1. Per your request, we have completed a review of several unusual incidents that occurred at a European location. A summary of these incidents, a discussion of some possible explanations for them, and recommendations for future actions are included in the enclosure.

2. Due to the unusual character of these events, and due to corroborating data limitations, this review must be considered as preliminary. It is anticipated that additional information from any future similar incidents would help narrow down some of the options considered.
